As such each of Moody's Investors Service España, S.A., S&P Global Ratings Europe Limited, Fitch Ratings Ireland Limited and DBRS Ratings GmbH are included in the list of credit rating agencies published by the European Securities and Markets Authority on its website in accordance with such Regulation.

According to Moody's Investors Service España, S.A., a rating of "Ba" indicates an obligation judged to be speculative and subject to substantial credit risk. The numerical modifier "1" indicates that the obligation ranks in the higher end of the generic "Ba" rating category.

According to S&P Global Ratings Europe Limited, a rating of "BBB" indicates that an obligation

exhibits adequate protection parameters. However, adverse economic conditions or changing circumstances are more likely to weaken the obligor's capacity to meet its financial commitments on the obligation. The modifier “-” indicates a ranking in the lower end of the “BBB” rating category.

According to DBRS Ratings GmbH, a rating in the “BBB” category indicates that the capacity for the payment of financial obligations is considered acceptable, although it may be vulnerable to future events. The modifier “(High)” indicates a ranking in the higher end of the “BBB” rating category.
